6) *Retrospections of 2017*

In administration, the biggest challenge we faced this year was the 30% rent increase that Los Gatos-Saratoga School District notified us of in July when the registration process was already complete in March. The unexpected expense had resulted in a budget increase by \$15,000 for MLCC.

This year MLCC administered the language skills assessment developed by ACTFL to our 8th grade students. The results show that students performed best in Listening, then reading, and needed improvement in Writing and Speaking. While we will continue to work hard at Chinese school, parents can help at home by talking to their students in Chinese about different topics to increase their exposure to the language.

To further improve the reading skills of our students, we have since put together a supplementary reading program for middle and upper grade classes. All fourth grade students will receive one-year free subscription to an online reader. It is our hope to boost student interest in reading in Chinese and help students develop the confidence and skills they need to read independently.

For professional development, we invited Dr. Theresa Jen from ACTFL to host a two-day workshop on Writing Assessment at our San Jose location. A total of 11 MLCC teachers attended the workshop.

MLCC continues to recruit new teachers as the school expands. This year six participants signed up for MLCC's Teacher Training Program, which has begun on 12/4.

This year MLCC offered Chinese after school program at seven private school sites, serving a total of 105 students.
