- *ii)* CFL K (for children ages 5-6) and CFL1 (for children ages 6-10)
 - The CFL program is specialized for students whose families do not speak Mandarin at home; CFLK takes 5-6 year olds, and CFL1 takes students ages 6 to 10. Classroom activities emphasize listening comprehension and speaking exercises. In addition to everyday conversation, students will also learn to recognize Chinese characters.
